The camp is designed to positively impact on student education through consolidation and new learning about the discovery of gold in Bathurst and students will be involved in the program 'Life in Colonial Australia' including gold panning. We will also visit some scenic famous sights such as Echo Point/ Three Sisters Lookout and Mount Panorama where the annual Bathurst 1000 is held.
